

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: - RECRUITMENT TO THE (05) FIVE VACANT POSITION (BS-16 TO 17) OF PAKISTAN ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (PAK-EPA), MINISTRY OF CLIMATE CHANGE.

The undersigned is directed to refer to Ministry of Climate Change's O.M. No. 2(18)/2017-Admn-II dated 24th February, 2023, on the subject noted above and to state that obtaining a prior NOC from this Division is mandatory before making prescribed kind of recruitment. Moreover, requisite staff with matching qualification, experience and grade is not available in the surplus pool for absorption against the reported vacant posts.
