

Subject: - RECRUITMENT AGAINST THE POST OF DIRECTOR PORTS & ADMINISTRATION (BS-19) & ENGINEER AND SHIP SURVEYOR (BS-18) DIRECTORATE GENERAL PORTS & SHIPPING WING, MINISTRY OF MARITIME AFFAIRS

The undersigned is directed to refer to Ministry of Maritime Affairs O.M.
