2. The course will be commencing from 17-10-2022. The nominated officers may report to NIMs, Karachi, Lahore, Islamabad and Quetta on 14th October, 2022. The above nominations are subject to provision of latest Annual Medical Examination Reports to be submitted to respective NIMs.

3. It is also pertinent to mention here that after the split of MCMC, into 10 weeks at NIM & 4 weeks at STI in accordance with the decision of Federal Cabinet, the course fee for each participant has been divided between the respective NIM and the Specialized Training Institutes, **which amounts to Rs.160,714/- per participant, at NIMs, Karachi Lahore, Peshawar and Quetta (10 weeks) and Rs.142,857/- per participant, at NIM, Islamabad and Rs.64,286/- per participant (4 Weeks) for Specialized Training Institutes.** The payment of course fee in respect of officers of occupational groups and Ex-cadre officers of all Ministries/ Divisions and their attached departments will be made by the Establishment Division while in case of officers of the Provincial Governments and autonomous

bodies/organizations etc. nominated for the course shall be arranged by their respective departments/governments etc., and to this effect payment shall be remitted to the respective Director General, NIM, through bank draft/cross cheque/pay order at the time of joining the course by the officer concerned or as early as possible.


4. As per the Prime Minister's directive, issued vide this Division's DO letter No. 5/11/2000-T-II/T-I dated 10-06-2014 all Ministries/Divisions/ Departments are bound to relieve the officers on their selection for training course without fail. The Ministries/Divisions/ Departments shall make stop-gap arrangements, as the nominated officers are not required to attend their offices while undergoing training. Non-compliance of the directions of the Prime Minister shall tantamount disciplinary proceedings under the Government Servants (E&D) Rules, 2020. Further, according to Rule 8 (b) of the Civil Servants Promotion (BPS-18 to BPS-21) Rules, 2019, if the officer fails thrice for any reason to attend the mandatory training will be recommended for supersession.
