NOTIFICATION

S.R.O. 384 (I)/2025.- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 25 of the Civil Servants Act, 1973 (LXXI of 1973), read with Notification No. S.R.O. 120(1)/98, dated the 27th February, 1999, the Prime Minister is pleased to direct that the following further amendment shall be made in the Occupational Groups & Services (Probation, Training and Seniority) Rules, 1990, namely: -

In the aforesaid Rules, in rule 3, for sub-rule (7), the following shall be substituted, namely: -

“(7) Qualifying the masters’ program or equivalent as notified by the Federal Board of Revenue shall be mandatory for probationers of Inland Revenue Service and Pakistan Customs Service effective from 52nd Common Training Program (CTP). The masters’ program and its evaluation shall be considered for all relevant rules and purposes under these rules and in addition to the marks specified in sub-rule (3), twelve hundred marks shall be allocated for masters’ program for the Probationers of aforesaid Services”.
